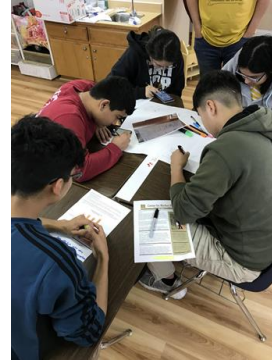


Figure 1. Youth-Driven Infographic Development Steps

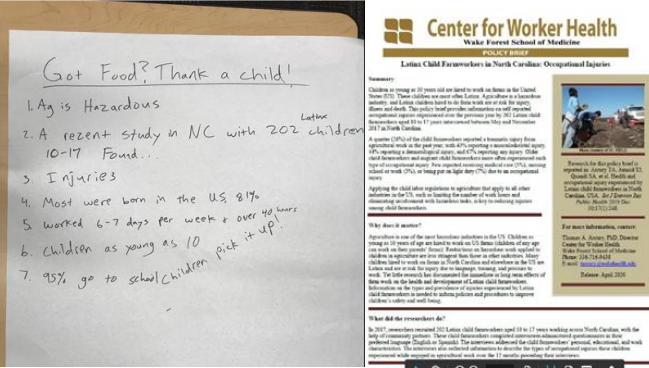
(1) Envisioning audience and purpose



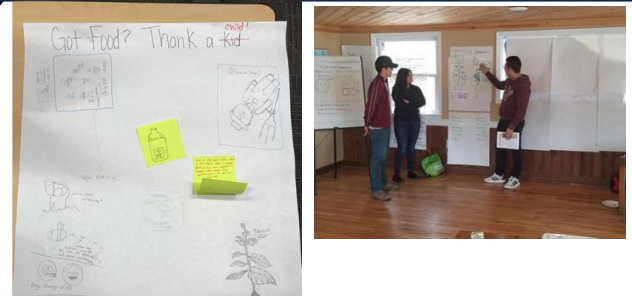
(2) Marking up policy briefs



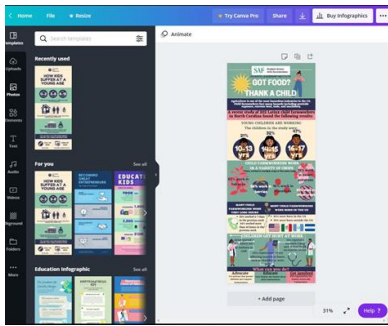
(3) Determining most important findings

(6) Reviewing and revising

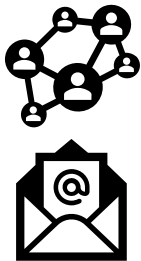
